SPECTATOR EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Spectators will not from boo, yell, insult, or criticize the officials, coaches, or players.
- 2. Spectators will use only their voices to cheer for their team. Noisemakers, horns, megaphones, etc. are not to be used during the games.
- 3. Spectators will cheer for and encourage player effort and skill.
- 4. Spectators should not coach during the game.
- 5. Spectators will not be argumentative or rude to other spectators.
- 6. Spectators will not shout profanity.

PLAYER EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Players will not yell, boo, insult, or criticize the officials, coaches, or other players.
- 2. Players will not use profanity.
- 3. Players will exhibit sportsmanship by not using words or actions to hurt others.
- 4. Players will not taunt each other.
- 5. Players will take a knee when another player is hurt and applaud when the player is able to recover.

COACH EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Coaches will not boo, insult, or criticize the officials, players, or other coaches.
- 2. Coaches will praise and encourage their players and opposing players, when appropriate.
- 3. Coaches will avoid "joystick coaching" during the game.
- 4. Coaches will model respect for officials and the opponents.
