Investments made in the league this last year:

- Invested in new catcher equipment and catcher gloves for multiple divisions.
- Invested in tees, throwdown bases and nets for teams to use.
- Invested in batter box mats for fields and batting cages.
- Invested in mound covers.
- Invested in a new pitching machine.
- Invested in special event canopies.
- Invested in new dugout covers for Ladera Palma fields.
- Invested in a professional coaches clinic featuring high school coaches.
