Team: All players will play at least one half of the game in the field, with free substitution, and all players will bat in the line-up. To field a team, you must have at least 6 of your own players and may borrow up to 3 from another team. A team may play with 4 outfielders, for a total of 10 players on the field.

Game: A game will be 1 hour with no new innings starting after 55 minutes. 5 4 run limit per inning. An inning is over when play on the last batter is dead (from an out or run rule) or pitcher has control of the ball in the 16 ft. circle. A game is over after 60 minutes regardless of where they are at in the game. (Games can end in a tie or one team has one more bat than the other).

Pitching/Catching: The pitcher will pitch from 30 feet. No wind-up is needed, modified pitching is legal. Coaches must pitch from the rubber at 30 feet. The pitcher must stay in the pitching circle and beside pitching rubber when the coach is pitching. When there is no circle, it is the discretion of the umpire. The circle is 16 feet in diameter around the pitching rubber. Pitching will be by players first and then the offensive coach. Players will throw a maximum of 3 pitches; offensive coaches will get a maximum of two pitches for a total of 5 pitches.

Batting: Each batter starts with a 0-0 count and may not have more than 5 pitches unless the last pitch is a foul ball. The at bat will continue if the 5th pitch is a foul ball then the offensive coach receives 1 more pitch. Players may strikeout before 5 pitches have been thrown.

Base Running: NO stealing at any time including home plate. A runner must be hit home to score.

Players and runners will stop when:

A ball that never leaves the infield: If no fielder has control of the ball the runners may continue to advance. However, once a fielder has control of the ball the runners should stop at the next base. This encourages the infielder to throw the ball to the appropriate base without the fear of runners advancing to the next base because of an overthrow.

A ball hit to the outfield:

If no outfielder has control of the ball the runners may continue to advance. Once the outfielder gains control of the ball and throws (releases) it toward the infield the runners will stop at the next base, even if the ball doesn't make it to the "dirt" on the throw. Exception, the outfielder can carry the ball to the infield to make an

Game: A game will be 1 hour and 10 minutes with no new innings starting after 1 hour and 5 minutes. 5 run limit per inning. An inning is over when play on the last batter is dead or the pitcher has control of the ball in the 16ft. circle. Games can end in a tie.

Pitching/Catching: A pitcher must start with the pivot foot on the rubber and their non-pivot foot in contact with or behind the rubber within 24".
