Code of Conduct

All Enterprise Jr. Hornets Football & Cheer (EJHFC) Parents, Coaches, and Board Members will abide by a Code of Conduct which includes the following provisions. If any of these rules are broken, EJHFC program, League, Sacramento Youth Football (SYF), and American Youth Football (AYF) shall have the authority to impose a penalty including permanent removal from the program. As an athlete, both on and off the field, I am a representative of Enterprise Junior Hornets and expected to act accordingly at all times.

EJHFC Shall:

1. Uphold the goals of EJHFC with association of contract through SYF umbrellaed under the AYF to ensure that all participants have the benefit of a safe and fun learning environment.
2. All parents, guardians and other adults and attendees of football and cheer events within these described associations, including but not limited to practices, competitions, and banquets, must behave accordingly in a respectful, courteous and sportsmanlike manner at all times.
3. Any adult who is using alcohol, tobacco or non-prescription drugs and/or appears intoxicated at a EJHFC, SYF, AYF and/or contracted bowl or competition event, and/or who is flagrantly rude, attempts to intimidate, verbally abuse, heckles, taunts, ridicules, boos, throws objects and/or uses vulgarity or profane language/gestures with an official, coach, volunteer, staff member, participant or other event attendee, must receive a verbal warning and/or be asked to leave a such event.
4. Each adult will help children and the athletes enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever they can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, or otherwise assisting the team/ organization.
5. EJHFC may also provide a written warning to the individual regarding the misbehavior or pending the circumstance removal from the program(s) completely. The adult's children may also be removed from the event or program. Any adult who is exhibiting such offenses in a habitual manner will be banned from any and all EJHFC events for a period of one year. This may be due to the actions of a second offense or the first offense required such actions out of the health and safety of others (physically or emotionally). The date will be determined by the date of the offenses that were displayed. These adults displaying these offenses may have their children removed from the program(s) for that time period.
6. Any adult who physically assaults an official, coach, volunteer, staff member or participant or threatens grave bodily harm may be banned from any and all EJHFC events for one year from the date of the offense, and their children may also be removed from any and all EJHFC programs for that same period of time.
7. If a ban has expired and an individual returns, if the individual commits another offense of the adult code of conduct, the individual will be permanently banned from any and all EJHFC events and the individual's children may also be permanently removed from any and all EJHFC programs. The EJHFC board of directors may also forgo such steps and banned adults for life if such behaviors warrant such consequences.
8. EJH reserves the right to refuse participation and may terminate without comment. All participants within the EJHFC recognize that EJHFC board members, officers, sponsors, coaches, volunteers, committee members, and supervisory personnel are not responsible for injuries to persons or damage to property other than insurance coverage.
