



2024 Majors City Tournament Rules

- The Host for the City Tournament will be Continental Little League. Games will be played at Dawson Field, and Field 2 both at Continental Park
- CLL will arrange and schedule all games, times, locations, and umpires.
- CLL will be responsible for all field preparation.
- CLL will have an official pitch counter for all games. The pitch count will be recorded through GameChanger, and the pitch count will be announced every half-inning.
- CLL will have an official scorekeeper for all games.
- CLL will be responsible for all game balls during the tournament.
- CLL will have a designated site representative present for any questions or protests.
- All protests will go through the umpire and will follow Little League protocol.
- Batting cage times will be 1 hour prior to the start of each game. Each team is limited to 45 minutes of cage time in a single aisle of the cages prior to their game.
- Seeding will be determined by overall season record, then head-to-head record, then average adjusted run differential. (Maximum run differential that will be counted towards the average is 10 runs/game)
- The higher seed will be designated as the home team. In the championship game, the team from the winner's bracket will be the home team. If a second game is required in the championship game series, the home team will be determined by a coin flip.
- The City Tournament will follow all Little League Major Division Tournament rules.
 - A continuous batting order will be used.
 - Defensively, 6 outs minimum play time will be used.
 - Minimum play violations will result in team disqualification.
 - There will be no new innings after 2 hour 00 minutes or complete game (prior to the time limit). All games will be played out, no game will end in a tie.
 - Run rule – 15 after 3 inning, 10 after 4 innings, 8 after five innings.
- Each team will be responsible for the behavior of their players and parents.
- CLL highly recommends that all players refrain from any contact with their parents during the course of the game.
