



GLL Divisional Equipment List

Tee Ball Division

- **Team Shirt & Hat** - Provided by GLL as part of registration fee.
- **Helmet** - Required while batting and running bases.
 - GLL will provide shared helmets.
 - Players may provide their own NOCSAE certified helmet, protective cage optional.
- **Glove** - Required, player provided.
- **Bat** - Optional, can be shared with teammates.
 - GLL provides 1-2 bats per team to share, players may provide their own.
 - Solid wood bats allowed.
 - Non-wood bats must have the **USABaseball logo**, and the words "Only for use with approved Tee Balls" on the barrel.
 - Additional bat info linked at bottom of this document.
- **Shoes** - NO METAL cleats, tennis shoes OK, plastic cleats OK, no sandals.
- **Pants** - Shorts/sweatpants/athletic pants all OK.

Softball - Rookies/Minors/Majors Divisions

- **Team Shirt & Visor** - Provided by GLL as part of registration fee.
- **Helmet** - Required while batting and running bases.
 - GLL will provide shared helmets with facemasks.
 - Players may provide their own NOCSAE certified helmet with a facemask or C-Flap; C-Flaps must be of the same manufacturer as the helmet.
- **Fielder's Face Mask** -
 - Required for pitcher, encouraged for all infielders.
 - GLL will provide a few per team, players may provide their own.
- **Glove** - Required, player provided.
- **Bat** - Optional, can be shared with teammates.
 - Must be a softball bat.
 - Solid wood bats allowed.
 - Non-wood bats shall state *Softball* on the barrel and have a BPF of 1.20.
 - Additional bat info linked at bottom of this document.
- **Catcher's Gear** - Required for catchers.
 - GLL provides a set of shared gear.
 - Players may provide their own gear, dangly throat guard required.
- **Shoes** - NO METAL cleats, tennis shoes ok, plastic cleats recommended.
- **Pants** - Softball/baseball pants, no specific requirements for color/style.
- **Belt** - Optional.
- **Socks** - Longer socks recommended, no specific color requirements.
- **Batting gloves** - Optional.



Baseball - Rookies & Minors Divisions

- **Team Shirt & Hat** - Provided by GLL as part of registration fee.
- **Helmet** - Required while batting and running bases.
 - GLL will provide shared helmets with facemasks.
 - Players may provide their own NOCSAE certified helmet with a facemask or C-Flap; C-Flaps must be of the same manufacturer as the helmet.
- **Athletic Cup** - Required for all male players, player provided.
- **Glove** - Required, player provided.
- **Bat** - Optional, can be shared with teammates.
 - Solid wood bats allowed.
 - Non-wood bats must have the **USABaseball logo** on the barrel.
 - Additional bat info linked at bottom of this document.
- **Catcher's Gear** - Required for catchers.
 - GLL provides a set of shared gear.
 - Players may provide their own gear, dangly throat guard required.
- **Shoes** -
 - **Rookies** - NO METAL cleats, tennis shoes OK, plastic cleats optional.
 - **Minors** - NO METAL cleats, tennis shoes OK, plastic cleats recommended.
- **Pants** -
 - **Rookies** - Sweatpants/athletic pants/baseball pants all OK.
 - **Minors** - Baseball pants required; gray/white/black all OK.
- **Belt** - Optional.
- **Socks** - No specific requirements, managers sometimes state color preference.
- **Batting gloves** - Optional.



Baseball - Intermediate/Juniors/Seniors Division

- **Team Shirt & Hat** - Provided by GLL as part of registration fee.
- **Helmet** - Required while batting and running bases.
 - GLL will provide shared helmets.
 - Players may provide their own NOCSAE certified helmet.
 - C-Flap use is optional, C-flaps must be of the same manufacturer as the helmet.
- **Athletic Cup** - Required for all male players, player provided.
- **Glove** - Required, player provided.
- **Bat** - Optional, can be shared with teammates.
 - Solid wood bats allowed.
 - Non-wood bats must have the **USABaseball logo** on the barrel.
 - *Note:* USABaseball bats are not allowed in Seniors division.
 - BBCOR bats allowed.
 - *Note:* BBCOR bats are AKA “drop 3” or “-3” (*weight minus the length*); drop 3 bats are heavy, smaller players may have trouble getting them around fast enough.
 - Additional bat info linked at bottom of this document.
- **Catcher’s Gear** - Required for catchers.
 - GLL provides a set of shared gear.
 - Players may provide their own gear, dangly throat guard required.
- **Shoes** - Metal and non-metal cleats allowed.
- **Pants** - Baseball pants required; gray/white/black all OK.
- **Belt** - Optional.
- **Socks** - No specific requirements, managers sometimes state color preference.
- **Batting gloves** - Optional.

GLL will occasionally have sales on used equipment (*pants, helmets, gloves, bats*). Those sales will be advertised as they become known.
