



Frequently Asked Questions

When is Registration open till?

Spring 2020 registration will be open until mid to late January 2020, depending on the number of players, teams and managers available.

How much is Registration?

The cost of registration is FREE (minus a \$5 service charge fee from website). However, to offset costs, each registered player will be required to participate in the league's fundraiser. The cost of the fundraiser (\$200) will be paid up front to complete your registration. Then each registered player will receive 20 - \$10 raffle tickets. The player (family), will have the option to either sell the raffle tickets to recoup their costs or keep the tickets for a chance to win the raffle.

What do I get with my registration?

All players will receive jersey, hat, little league patch, name on back of jersey, insurance, umpires (Minors division and above), yearbook and basic picture package. All T-ballers and Machine/Coach Pitch teams will receive medals or trophies at end of the season. All other divisions (based on number of teams and placement) will receive 1st and 2nd trophies at end of the season.

How do I register my child?

Easy. Please log onto www.whittierlittleleaque.org, select the REGISTER icon (top right hand side of the page). Create an account (user name / password, etc.) Then register your child.

I registered my player, now what happens?

The league will hold Player Evaluations in mid to late January for all LEAGUE age players 7 years old and up. If you are unable to attend, there will be a makeup date for evaluations. Once all the evaluations have been completed, the Players draft will be held. For T-ball & Machine/Coach Pitch divisions, players will be automatically placed on a team. All teammate and coach requests will be considered.

When does the season begin and end?

Practices will begin in February. Games begin in March and run through May.

When and where are practices held at?

Practices are based upon the manager's availability. Generally, you will have 1-3 practices a week at the beginning of the season. Once games start, practices are held 1-2 times a week. For practices, we can practice at Orchard Dale ES, Hillview MS and sometimes York Field. Also for T-ball (T-ball ONLY), Parnell Park can be used. Practices start after 4pm.

When and where are the games played at?

All T-ball, Machine & Coach Pitch games are played at Orchard Dale ES. For other divisions, we do interleague with Murphy Ranch, La Habra & Hacienda Heights Little League. Game locations and days/times will vary. You will have one (1) game during the week (M-Th) and one game on the weekend, generally Saturday. For our 50/70 (Intermediate) division, games are played on Sunday's.

How many games are played?

You will play anywhere from 15-20 regular season games.

I want to manage my son or daughter's team. How do I do that?

Little League is a volunteer based organization. We could not survive without all the time, hard work and dedication put forth by our volunteers. To manage a team, please select "I want to manage a Team" option during the Registration process. You can also e-mail League President Dustin @ info@whittierlittleleague.org and make him aware as well. All volunteers must submit too and pass a Background check.

I want to join the Board of Directors. How do I that?

Please e-mail League President Dustin @ <u>info@whittierlittleleague.orq</u> and make him aware. Or, look for and speak with a board member at a Registration or League Event. The Board meets once a month, for 1-2 hours. There are various board position openings. Join today!
