



2022 Spring Ball Registration

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When does the season start?

A: Northwest Downey Little League's 2022 Spring Season is scheduled to start on February 2nd, 2022 and conclude on May 21st, 2022.

Q: Where are games and practices held at and how many games are there?

A: Games are played at Furman Park and spread out to two games a week (typically one weekday game and one Saturday game). Practices are held at a location chosen by your child's coach. Practice times also vary depending on your coach's availability.

Q: What division does my son qualify for?

A: NWDLL offers several divisions for different ages. If your child is between 7-11 years old, they will be required to participate in a tryout to see what division he/she will be placed into. The divisions are as follows: Majors division (ages 9-12), Minor A (ages 8-11), and Minor B (ages 7-9). And again, all players will be placed in a division based on how they perform at the tryout. Kids that are 5 years old with 1 year of T-Ball experience are encouraged to play up to Minor C division where they are introduced to Coach Pitch with the option to hit off the Tee. Players ages 3-5 with no baseball experience will be placed in our T-ball division. Juniors and Seniors Divisions are for kids that are 13 or older. We also offer a Challenger Division that has games every Saturday morning and is made up of our youth that have special needs. Challenger Division is free of charge.

Q: What do my fees include?

A: As NWDLL is a non-profit organization, our goal is to make baseball accessible to all children within our boundaries. The registration fee covers our online registration platform, Snack shack Deposit (Refundable after working 4 hours), Team Uniform (Jersey, hat, socks and belt), team pictures, league insurance, field maintenance and to replace any damaged team equipment. We also require players to participate in a fundraiser during the season. You may be required to pay the "opt-out fee" if you decide to not participate in the fundraiser.
