

To all IVYSL Coaches, Volunteers, Team Managers, Referees and Board Members

All coaches, board members, referees, team managers, administrators, independent contractors, and employees must comply with the federal Safe Sport Act of 2017, US Youth Soccer, and the US Soccer Safe Sport and Prohibited Conduct Policies. Participant means and adult authorized by IYSA or a Local Area Affiliated Organization (League/Club/Team) to have regular contact with or authority over an amateur athlete who is a minor

Illinois Youth Soccer has teamed up with Sports Engine to help keep kids safe with a streamlined safety program that includes industry leading background screenings, Safe Sport Training and CDC Heads Up Concussion Training for all participants in your organization. IYSA will be following the required National Council of Youth Sports (NCYS), US Soccer and US Youth Soccer screening criteria to determine participation

Effective today all participants in your organization must submit their background screening, Safe Sport Training and CDC Heads Up Concussion Training through the Sports Engine/NCSI link on the IYSA website. IYSA will not accept any other search.

When registering you must list Illinois Valley Youth Soccer League as your league selection, if that is in fact your league of participation
