

MVLL PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

Mill Valley Little League has adopted the following Code of Conduct for parents with children in our program. So that the League knows you are aware of its terms, your signature is required at the end.

Each parent understands and agrees that:

1. The goals of the League are to improve skills, promote teamwork, and allow players to have fun and enjoy the game of baseball. I accept responsibility to assist the League with these goals, and to refrain from incompatible conduct.
2. I will keep my child's coaches aware of any physical disability or ailment that may affect my child's safety or the safety of others.
3. I will promote good sportsmanship by positive support and by avoiding comments or behavior that could reasonably be construed as abuse, intimidation, ridicule, disrespect or disdain toward any team, player, coach, umpire or other participant in the League.
4. I will place the physical and emotional well-being of the players ahead of any personal desire to win, and will not measure the quality of my child's baseball experience by whether a game has been won or lost.
5. I will strive to ensure my child treats players, coaches, umpires and spectators with respect, regardless of race, creed, color, gender or ability.
6. I will inquire about and follow the League's procedures to address any issues of concern to me regarding the League and its operations, or any coach, umpire, official or volunteer, before presenting any issue to the community via emails, letters or similar communications.
7. I will notify the League if I observe any violations of League policy by a player, coach, umpire, volunteer or spectator, and will cooperate with the League's investigation of the matter.
8. I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol, and will refrain from using them while attending any game, practice or other League sanctioned event where youth are present.
9. I will refrain from involving myself in games or practices unless requested to do so by an official coach of my child's team.

10. I will require that my child's coaches uphold the MVLL Coaches Code of Conduct, but if I have any concerns about the actions of a coach, umpire or other League official, I will discuss it with the appropriate person(s) off the field and at a mutually acceptable time and place.

Mill Valley Little League reserves the right to investigate any allegation regarding a violation of this Code by any person, and to take appropriate corrective action. This action may include immediate removal from the current event, and suspension from attending one or more future games.
