



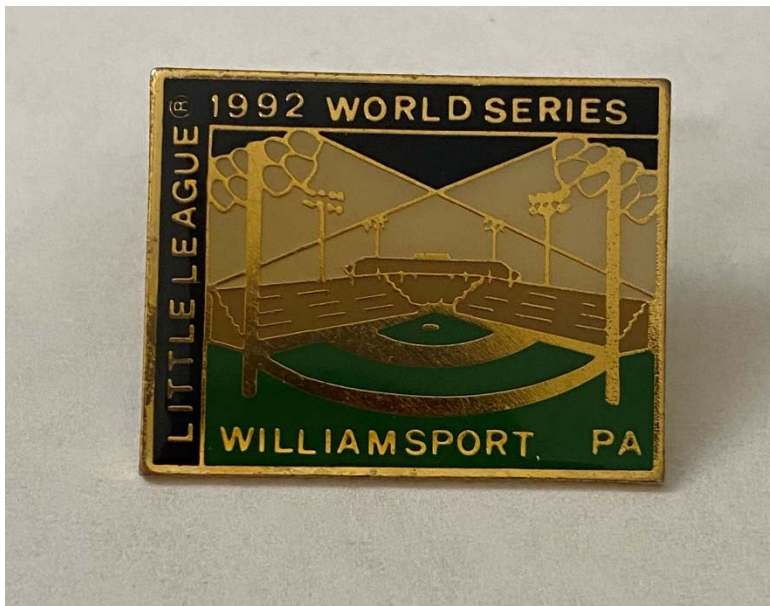
This league pin was designed to incorporate a man on horseback in front of a castle that is named for Sayen Park where Nottingham Little League plays.



This pin was created after the team's LLWS run. The larger flag was added to highlight the team's achievements of their NJ State Championship, East Regional Championship and World Series Appearance.



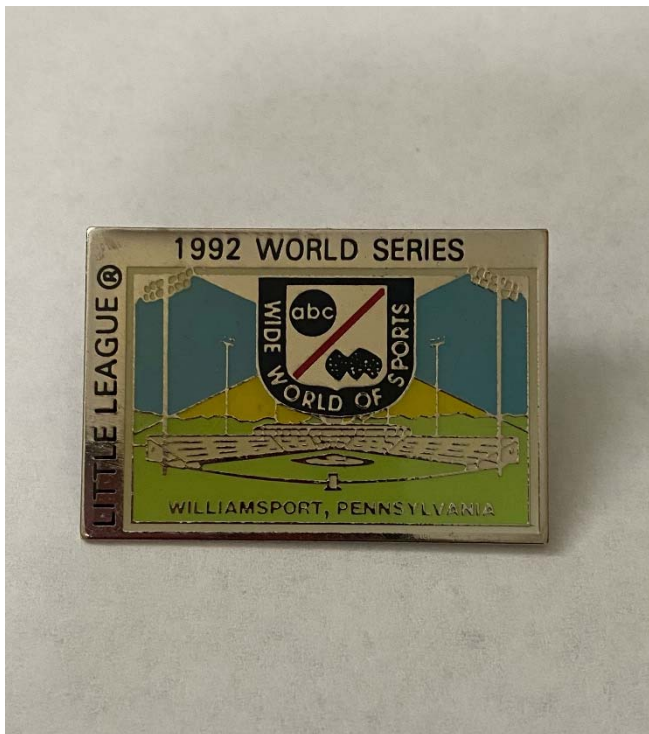
This pin is similar to the 2 above with the additional caption "If you can dream it, you can do it" which refers to Nottingham's historic LLWS run.



This is the official pin of the 1992 Little League World Series. The pin's design incorporates Lamade Stadium and the new Musco lighting system designed specifically for the field which allowed each team to play more games during the series.



This pin was created to commemorate the very first game at the Little League World Series to be played under the newly installed lights. Nottingham, representing the East Region played in this game against the South Region team from Lake Charles, Louisiana. Nottingham earned the win 5-0. This pin shows the box score from that game.



This is the official pin ABC Sports for the 1992 Little League World Series. The pin's design also incorporates Lamade Stadium and the new lighting system. This pin was given to members of the media covering the LLWS and features a more colorful design than shown on the official LLWS sold to spectators.



Designed in 2002 to celebrate the 10 year anniversary of Nottingham playing in the first ever night game at the Little League World Series. The pin features lights above the field design to commemorate this historical milestone.



This is a pennant created after the team's LLWS journey to celebrate their achievements of winning the NJ State Championship, Eastern Region Championship and being a World Series Finalist.
