## Wanaque Recreation 3 on 3 Outdoor Youth Basketball League Rules

League's philosophy is to have fun, foster teamwork and promote sportsmanship and allowing players to learn basic fundamentals of the game of basketball.

## COVID safety and social distancing rules apply- See separate attachment

- All Games are full court play on outdoor courts at Back Beach Park
- 3 on 3 basketball games are played by two teams of 3 players each, with a maximum of 3 substitutions
- Two games are scheduled to be played every Saturday with a 5 minute break between games
- 5 Week Season All Games played on Saturdays
- 4 Divisions Boys Senior Grades 6-8, Girls Senior Grades 6-8, Boys Junior Grades 3-5 Girls Junior Grades 3-5
- Each Division will consist of 4 teams
- Start Date October 20 End Date November 7
- Game Start Times
- Girls Junior 12:00 \& 12:25
- Boys Junior 1:00 \& 1:25
- Girls Senior 2:00 \& 2:25
- Boys Senior 3:00 \& 3:25
- 5 Minute Break between games, with 15 minute break between league games
- Sign up at Blue Sombero https://tshq.bluesombrero.com/wanaquenj
- Computer assigns player to team
- Player Fee $\$ 20$


## High School rules apply with the following exceptions

- Ball Size Senior Boys will use 29.5 Senior Girls and Junior Boys and Junior Girls will use 28.5
- Games are 20 minutes running time
- Only 1 overtime of 3 minutes will be played for any games that are tied at the end of regulation, if game still ends in a tie, both teams will be awarded a tie
- Clock will only stop for time outs, substitutions and injuries.
- Each team is allowed two 45 second time outs. Time outs do not carry over. Clock will stop for time outs.
- No time outs in overtime
- No JUMP BALL- Visiting team gets the ball to start the game and alternate possession rules apply the rest of the game
- Players are out of the game after committing 5 personal fouls
- Teams must have 3 players to start the game, but can play with less than 3 if no substitutes are available
- No pressing in back court
- Half court pressure can only be applied in last two minutes of play unless winning by 10 points or more
- If a team is winning by 10 points or more, they must remain inside the 3 point line on defense. Once the winning team drop below 10 points, they can come back out of the 3 point line
- Three second rule violations applies- in the younger league ref can warn players more for a learning moment
- Every player must play one half of the game.
- If a team uses a sub from another team, that sub cannot play more time than the team's players
- If technical or intentional fouls are committed- 1 point will be automatically awarded to the other team along with possession of the ball.
- Players will be ejected from the game for unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Only 1 ref per game
- Home Team is designated as the official scorebook


## Scoring

- 2 points awarded for made 2 point shots and 3 points for shots made beyond the 3 point line
- Only 1 Free Throw awarded- if player is fouled in act of shooting (or in bonus situation)
- Free Throw Point will equal the amount of points that could have been made if all free throws were awarded i.e. if fouled while taking 3 point shot, made free throw then equals 3 points
