Reese Division Rules

- Distance between bases 70 feet
 Distance between pitchers mound and home plate 50 feet 6 inches
- 2. Baseball provided by the Wallen league
 Maximum bat width is 2 3/4", maximum bat length in 33"
 Maximum game length 6 innings
- 3. All players must play at least 6 defensive outs in the first 4 innings within a legal game, and 9 defensive outs within a full game.
- 4. The game is complete as the last batter completes his time at-bat.

 No inning shall begin once the game has been in progress for 1 hour 40 minutes.

 For timing purposes, the next inning begins immediately after the 3rd out has been recorded in the previous inning.
- 5. Continuous batting order will be used.
- 6. Pitching limitations refer to Washington Township general rules.
- 7. Stealing any base is permitted. Lead-offs are permitted.
- 8. No intentional walks are allowed.
- 9. The batter may run on a dropped 3rd strike, per NFHS rules.
- 10. No head-first slides are permitted unless the runner is returning to the base they came from.
- 11. Four innings of play, or reaching the time limit, constitutes a legal game.
- 12. A 15-run mercy rule will apply after 4 innings of play, while a 10-run mercy rule will apply after 5 innings of play.

- 13. Where Washington Township rules do not apply, MLB rules will apply.
- 14. One coach must be in the dugout
- 15. A pitcher is only allowed one mound appearance per game. They may not reenter onto the mound within the same game. This includes a situation in which they have not recorded 12 consecutive outs, or if they are under their minimum pitch counts allowed for that age group.
- 16. Regarding balks, one warning will be issued. No warnings will occur in a tournament or all-star game.
- 17. All rules are subject to change due to any extraordinary situation. Any change will be determined and approved by the Executive Board of Wallen.
