Document Purpose

- To provide guidance to reduce the incidence and spread of Covid-19 infection in our communities by supporting a safer environment for all who participate in Healdsburg Little League (HLL)
- To provide guidance on what to do if a HLL participant (player and non-player) tests positive for or is exposed to Covid-19
- To ensure HLL is aligned with Little League International (LLI) District 35 guidance which recommends having a documented Covid-19 response plan
- To ensure HLL remains active (e.g., games, practices, fundraisers) in the event an entity requires such documentation; categories of those entities are but not limited to:
 - State/local public health organization (e.g., Sonoma County Department of Public Health)
 - Other stakeholder groups to which HLL relies (e.g., Healdsburg Unified School District)

2. Follow new HUSD exposure/quarantine flowchart (see pictures below)

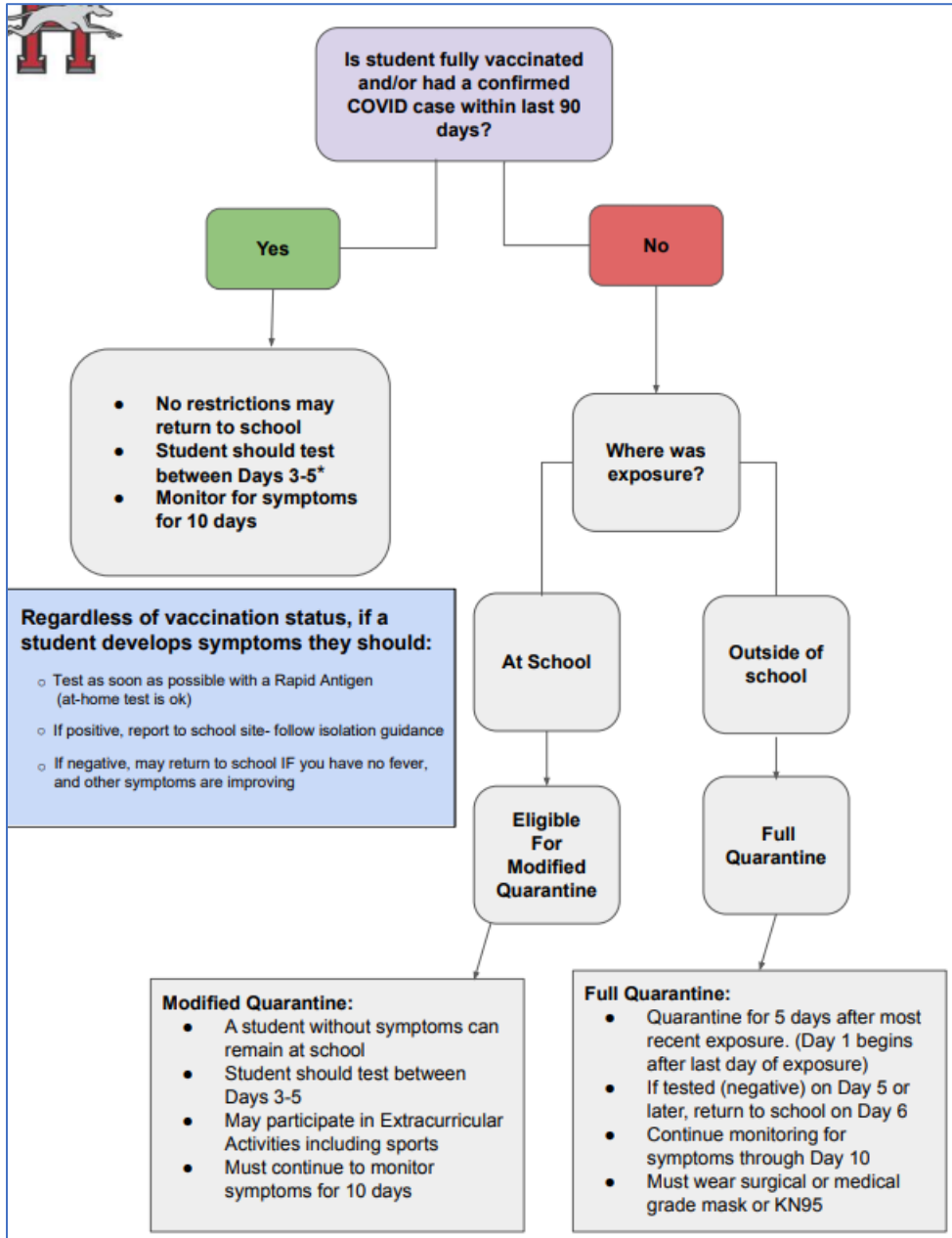


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ENGLISH – Exposure Flowchart



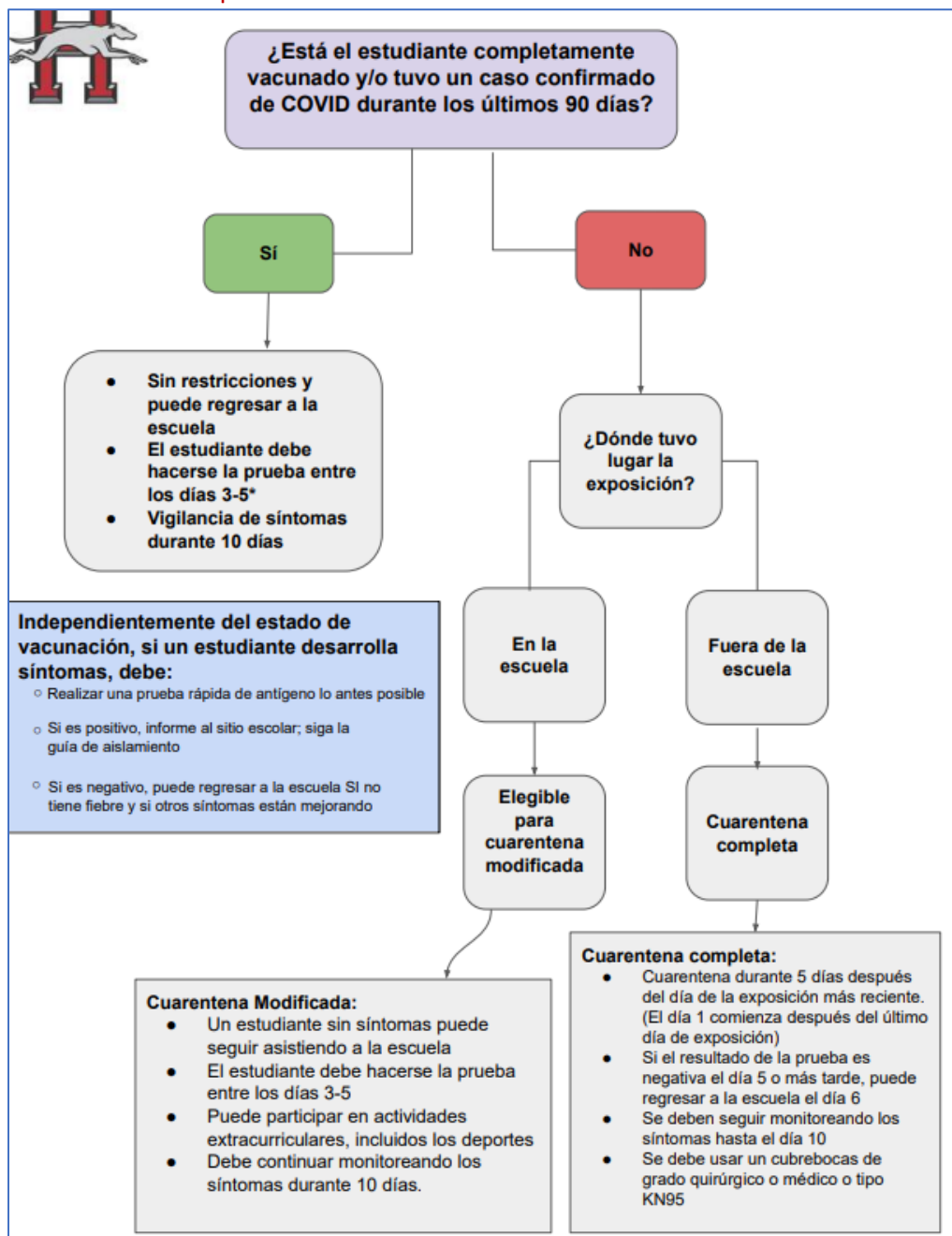


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SPANISH – Exposure Flowchart
