The WSBI fall league is for those players entering 7th thru 9th grade. Players from that age range are combined on teams. **We accept both individual registrations as well as teams from all surrounding communities.** Players entering 6th grade may play if parents/WSBI feel they are ready to move up. Individual player registrations will be assigned teams and play will begin on Saturday August 10th. The season runs through the end of September/beginning of October. Games are played Monday – Saturday on Wooster Summer Baseball's PNC Fields located at the intersection of State Route 585 and Long Road in Wooster. Sunday games are a possibility depending on team availability. Each player receives a numbered shirt with the team sponsor's name. The sponsor name is the team's name and our sponsor indicates shirt color preference.

Fee: \$110.00 / Early bird \$5 discount available if you register by July 4th! Multi-player family discount of \$20 per player after the first registration, and payment plan are available.

WOOSTER SUMMER BASEBALL INC
FALL BALL GUIDELINES AND EXPECTATIONS

Fall Ball is an opportunity to get in more games, develop player's skills, try a new position, get more at bats, etc. The fall league will observe rules listed in the 2018 NFHS Baseball Rules Book. The exceptions to these rules are listed below.

1. The distance between bases shall be 80 feet.
2. The distance between the nearer edge of the pitcher's plate and the rear tip of home plate shall be approximately 55 feet for 6th, 7th, and 8th graders and 60 feet 6 inches for 9th graders.
3. The bat measurements rule shall not be in effect. Any unaltered manufactured bat including Little League bats are considered legal.
4. Verbal warnings will be given for any balk.
5. One umpire will be provided for each game.
6. Pitcher may pitch as much as desired at the discretion of the coach.
7. Metal or plastic spikes/cleats may be used.
8. The game shall end when the visiting team is behind by 10 or more runs after 4 ½ innings, or after the 5th inning if either team is 10 runs behind and both teams have had an equal number of times at bat. If both team's coaches and the umpire agree to continue the game may continue for practice.
9. Games may end before 7 innings of play if, at the umpire's discretion, it is determined there is not enough light to continue.
10. Coaches, players, and umpires clothing requirements will not be enforced.

General Responsibilities

11. WSBI provides a numbered shirt for each player. Sponsor is team's name and determines shirt color.
12. WSBI provides the field for each game.
13. WSBI provides the umpire for each game.
14. WSBI will provide 2 game balls for each game.
15. Bring your bat, helmet, batting gloves, and water bottle to each game and practice.
16. It is the responsibility of all coaches to put the batter's box in. There is lime and batter box frames in each third base storage area. **DO NOT LOCK STORAGE ROOM ON FIELD #1.**
17. Players are to sweep dug-outs, empty trash cans in dugouts, seating areas, and concession stand.
18. Players are to rake around bases, pitcher's mound and batter's box.

Concession Stand (if your game is on Field #1)

19. Home team needs two adults (or responsible almost adults) working in the concession stand. Please arrive 30 minutes early.
20. It will be stocked and have prices for the items being sold
21. There will be change in the money drawer
22. Unlock restrooms
23. At game conclusion clean up, turn lights out in both RR and concession stand, and LOCK UP
