This includes, but not limited to pizza parties, Bar-B-Q's, swim parties, and/or field trips. The Code of Conduct shall govern the behavior of all Managers, Coaches, Assistant Coaches, Team Parents, players, spectators, fans, and League Officials. Parent/Guardian signature of the Code of Conduct indicates agreement to adhere to all Rules of Little League International, Modesto Empire Little League Rules, and Modesto Empire Little League Code of Conduct by all members of the player's family.
