Mountain View Recreation Center Little Pee Wee Rules (3-4 year old)

- 1. Age: 4 and Under (players cannot turn five (5) before May 1st)
- 2. Player Roster: Each team will consist of 10 to 12 players. Each team will bat through their entire lineup every inning. All players will take defensive positions on the field. 5 players should be positioned in normal infield positions (Pitcher, First base, Second base, Short Stop, and Third Base). The remaining players shall be placed in the outfield area (behind the base paths). Coaches are strongly encouraged to rotate players on defense to allow every player an opportunity to play all positions.
- 3. Game Length: Four (4) innings or 60 minute time limit. Each team should bat through their entire roster at least twice during the course of a game (every player should bat at least twice a game)
- 4. All batters will hit the ball from a batting tee. The tee should be adjusted to such a height that the batter will be able to swing level
- 5. If a batter hits part of the ball and part of the rubber tee, it is a fair ball. If a batter hits all rubber (the tee only), it is a foul ball
- 6. Protective headgear (batting helmets) must be worn on deck, at bat, and while on bases
- 7. Base running: Base stealing or leading off is not permitted. Base runners are not allowed to leave the base before the ball is put into play
- 8. Two (2) defensive coaches will be allowed on the field to provide instruction to all defensive players. Coaches are not allowed to touch the players when the ball is in play
- 9. A coach or team representative will place the ball on the tee for their players when batting and may coach the players from the field. An offensive coach is allowed to coach at first and third base when their team is batting. Coaches are not allowed to touch the players when the ball is in play
- 10. All teams are responsible for cleaning trash out of the dugouts at the end of the game
- 11. All teams are responsible for working the concessions at their appointed times
