

## Parent/Guardian's Code of Conduct and Commitment

- Obey all rules and regulations of the Crown Colony Baseball league.
- Understand that any removal of my player and/or my family member from a game, practice or Crown Colony event will result in suspension for the remainder of that game, practice or event plus one additional game.
- If I have a problem/conflict with the manager or coaches, I will not approach them during or after a game. I will call the coach to discuss the matter or set a meeting with the manager or coach to discuss the matter.
- Honor and respect the decisions of the Officer on duty, umpire or coach even if I don't agree
- Encourage my child to give 100% no matter where the coach plays them on the field or in the lineup. I will not ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake or for losing a game
- Refrain from giving the players instruction during a game—allow the coaches to manage the team and the game.
- Get my child to practice and games on time.
- Let my child's coach know at least 1 ½ hour prior to a practice, game or league event that they will not be able to attend the activity.
- Refrain from dugout visits.
- Set a good example. Children learn best by example
- Inform the coach of any medical condition or ailment that may affect the safety of my player. Abide by a doctor's decision in all matters of health, injuries and ability to play.
- Remember children are involved in organized sports for their enjoyment, not mine.
- · Help my child:
  - Learn the Little League rules of the game
  - o Hard work and honest effort is more important than victory
  - Learn good sportsmanship on and off the field of play
  - Skill improvement
- Do not publically question an umpire's judgment. Accept the umpire's decision and respect the fact they make mistakes too.
  They only have two eyes watching the whole field.
- Participate in:
  - Team activities
  - o Volunteer to help scorekeeping & prepping the field prior or after a game or anything else the coach needs help with.
  - Helping with removing verbal and physical abuse from youth sporting.
- Understand and acknowledge that the player registration fee is nonrefundable. If a child is dismissed or voluntarily leaves a team the parents are not entitled to a refund and all monies are forfeited.

In order to advance the principles of sportsmanship and to promote mutual respect among players, coaches, umpires and spectators Crown Colony has established this Code of Conduct. The Code of Conduct shall govern the actions of players, coaches and spectators and provide behavioral guidance and establish clear expectations for all involved. Any person violating the Code shall be subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination of the privilege to participate in or attend any and all Crown Colony sponsored activities.
