Code of Conduct

The following Code of Conduct is in effect during games, practices, team meetings and all other SPPPA sponsored events

Players Code of Conduct

- 1. I will not use or be under the influence of illegal drugs, alcohol and/or tobacco at all times. The SPPPA has a zero tolerance policy regarding a players' use of these substances at any team events.
- 2. Conduct myself in a manner that shows good sportsmanship.
- 3. Refrain from taunting and/or physical confrontation.
- 4. It is okay if I am not one of the best players as long as I work to the best of my ability.
- 5. I understand that while winning is a goal; it is only one of many goals. I should always do my best to help my team be successful, but it is okay to lose and still have a positive fun experience.
- 6. As a member of a team, I understand that we will win together and lose together as a team. It is not one individual that wins or loses the game.
- 7. I will not criticize players on my team or another team for not making a good or correct play. The coaching staff is in place to make necessary corrections.
- 8. In accordance with good sportsmanship, I can nicely help a teammate calm down if they get too angry.
- 9. Show **<u>RESPECT</u>** to all teams' coaches, players and umpires.
- 10. Attend practices, games and team events as scheduled.
- 11.Refrain from any actions, which would bring discredit to myself, my family, my team and/or the South Plainfield Tigers and SPPPA organization.
- 12.If I adhere to this Code of Conduct, I have earned the right to play in each game.

Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

- 1. Refrain from using or being under the influence of illegal drugs, and/or alcohol at all team events.
- 2. Refrain from using tobacco during all team events in the proximity of the playing fields.
- 3. Conduct myself in a manner that shows good sportsmanship.
- 4. Refrain from taunting and/or physical confrontation.
- 5. I understand that even though my child may not be the best player or a great player they should be praised for their accomplishments on the field, no matter how big or small.
- 6. I will not criticize a player on our team or another team for not making a good or correct play. The coaching staff is in place to make necessary corrections.
- 7. I understand and will reinforce with my child that while winning is a goal; it is only one of many goals.
- 8. It is okay to lose. As long as children try their best and are having fun, they are winners even if they lose the game.
- 9. I understand and will reinforce with my child that the team will win together and lose together. It is not one individual that wins or loses the game.
- 10. We shouldn't let our natural competitive spirit turn into angry yelling at our players when they don't meet our expectations.
- 11. When the players think we're angry, it can make them nervous and lower their self-esteem. This can have a negative effect on how they perform in the game.
- 12. Show RESPECT to all teams' coaches, players and umpires.
- 13.No parent will taunt, criticize or question any umpire(s) before, during or after any game
- 14.Know and help my child meet the level of commitment expected regarding their attendance at scheduled practices, games and team events.
- 15.Refrain from any actions, which would bring discredit to my child's team and/or the South Plainfield Tigers and SPPPA organization.
- 16.Read the copy of the By-Laws, Article 10, which pertains to the Travel Teams.

- 18.I understand that I will be responsible to explain the Code of Conduct to any and all of my family members who attend practices, games and functions. I will be responsible for their actions if there is a violation of the Code of Conduct
- 19.I will reinforce with my child her need to adhere to the Code of Conduct.

Managers/Coaches/Assistants Code of Conduct

- Refrain from using and/or being under the influence of illegal drugs and/or alcohol. The SPPPA has a zero tolerance policy regarding a coach's use and/or being under the influence of these substances at any team events.
- 2. Refrain from using tobacco during all team events in the proximity of the playing fields.
- 3. Conduct myself in a manner that shows good sportsmanship at all times.
- 4. Refrain from taunting and/or physical confrontation.
- 5. To only expect the players to try their best and to play to the best of their ability.
- 6. I understand and will help my team understand that while winning is a goal; it is only one of many goals. It is okay to lose.
- 7. The players can and should have a positive, fun experience even when they are not winning.
- 8. Learning to accept losing is an important lesson that we can help teach the kids.
- 9. As a member of a team, I understand that we will win together and lose together as a team.
- 10.It is not one individual that wins or loses the game.
- 11.Refrain from our natural competitive spirit that can make us negative and angry with the kids when they don't meet our expectations.
- 12. When the kids think I am angry I understand it can make them feel nervous and lower their self-esteem.
- 13. Too much criticism can reduce a player's enthusiasm and have a negative effect on how they perform.
- 14.I should offer positive suggestions for improvement.
- 15.Show RESPECT to all teams' coaches, players and umpires.
- 16. Attend practices, games and team events as scheduled.
- 17.Refrain from any actions, which would bring discredit to my team and/or the South Plainfield Tigers and SPPPA organization.
- 18.I know and will teach the players on my team the softball skills and strategies necessary for their level of play (based on the age group of the team).
- 19.I will adhere to the SPPPA's By-Laws.
- 20. Always remember I am here for all of the kids on my team and I am a role model to them
