



2024 Flag Football League Info SheetWith the West Licking-NFL Flag Football League

This is a partnership between the LHYSL, SW Licking, and the Buckeye Valley YMCA to form a larger, more competitive flag football league for Western Licking County.

LHYSL provides a fun, non-contact, developmental Coed Flag Football experience for boys and girls, K to grade 6 kids. We will teach fundamentals, conditioning, discipline, sportsmanship, and teamwork as it pertains to Coed non-contact flag football in a fun atmosphere.

This league will concentrate on passing, running, receiving, route running, and defensive coverage. This league serves as great steppingstone for kids that are interested in tackle football or help skills for the kids who already compete in tackle football.

· Flag Football League will be made up of 3 COED divisions.

Mini -- Kindergarten, 1st, and 2nd grade age players

Junior – 3rd and 4th grade age players

Junior – 5th & 6th grade age players

Each division will have more than one team or may be combined depending on registration numbers. Participants may be assigned to a division differing from their grade based on size and skill.

Flag Football General Information (practice & game)

- ✓ Each team will participate in organized football drills.
- ✓ Each team will have at least 10-15 players and at least (2) coaches that will teach fundamentals.
- ✓ Practices and games will usually be on the weekend (Sunday afternoons).
- ✓ Each team has the option to have practice once a week.
- ✓ There will be a draft after evaluations. Teams are determined by skills & grades. Approved by each organization's Football Director.
- ✓ Each team has the option to have (1) practice once during each week.
- ✓ There will be practice first then after will be game after the practice session. Practice is usually an hour then the game is appx 30 45 min.
- ✓ Each team will compete against other teams from the YMCA and SWL.
- ✓ All games will be 7on7 using NFL/USA Flag Football Rules
- ✓ The locations of practice/games will be LH Craig Field, SWL Lions Club, & the YMCA fields.
- ✓ Each season will end with a Championship / Awards day that will be at the YMCA.
- ✓ Transportation to and from practices and games is the responsibility of the Parents.

· Flag Football Participant Information

- ✓ All registration will be online at www.lhysl.org
- ✓ All children, Boy and Girls, eligible to register from kindergarten age up to 6th grade age.
- ✓ All participants will receive (1) game jersey that will be reversable, NFL style.
- ✓ The league will provide flags for all practices and games.
- ✓ Each participant is responsible and must have the following:
 - Mouthpiece / Mouthguard (this is mandatory to play)
 - Black shorts without pockets
 - Cleats (football or soccer) NO baseball or metal cleats
 - Water for Hydration
- ✓ This will be a 7–9-week league. If you sign your child up for this league, he or she is expected to be at all practices and games. Poor attendance will result in reduced playing time.
- ✓ Playing time: There is NO minimum playing time for any athletes. Our coaches will try and play everyone and keep all involved. Attendance, attitude, and effort will help the most for play time.

- ✓ Our goal is to manage all practices and games at each location in the same manner, and also to enforce flag football game rules consistently across the league.

- Anybody that registers through the LHYSL website will be subject to LHYSL bylaws and Code of Conduct the same as any other program the LHYSL offers.
