Mid-March: Practices begin

Late-March: Games begin (after Spring Break)

Mandatory Skill Evaluation (minors/majors only): March 4th or 5th, time and place TBD. Please do not stress about the evaluation. Players with all different levels of development will be there. It is simply a way to help WRLL set up roughly even teams skill-wise. Therefore: t is imperative that all players attend a session.
