PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

By registering your child in CVYFA, you have agreed to the parent rules and responsibilities set forth in CVYFA's PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT.

Please be aware, these rules apply to both parents and/or guardians REGARDLESS of signing an agreement.

These guidelines are set up by *Northern Arizona Youth Football* and Chino Valley Youth Football to ensure that the children playing in the program have a safe and fun environment in which to participate.

PARENT RULES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Parents are responsible for notifying the coach of any injuries, illness, or other health problems which may affect their child's athletic ability.
2. Football is a physical contact sport in which injuries, including serious injuries, can occur and you should only allow your child to take part in football with CVYFA if you accept the risks involved.
3. Parents are responsible for contacting the coach or assistant coach BEFORE their child misses any practices or games.
4. Parents WILL NOT interfere with coaches duties.
5. Do not publicly question referee judgment and never question their honesty.
6. Parents are not allowed to stand on the sidelines. Parents must stay in the stands if possible, or 10 feet behind the sidelines within 25 yard lines.
7. Parents are financially responsible for taking care of equipment assigned to their child. Inform your coach immediately if your child's equipment is lost or broken.
8. NO alcohol, drugs, smoking, or chewing at any CVYFA game or practice. At Del Rio Elementary we are not allowed to have sunflower seeds or peanuts, anything that can leave trash on the ground.
9. NO profanity. We try to give the children a positive environment to play, please keep all comments as positive as possible.
10. Set a good example Children learn best by example.

IN ADDITION:

11. Any parent and/or guardian of a participant, signing or not signing the registration form, WILL NOT intimidate or threaten a coach, board member, referee, player, or any other parent or spectator.

VIOLATION OF THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN:

1. First offense: Warning.
2. Second offense: One game suspension.
3. Third offense: Suspension for the remainder of the season.
4. Fourth offense: Their child automatically being suspended for the season and registration fees forfeited.
