

2025 TEE BALL DIVISION LOCAL RULES

Players need to have fun and fall in love with the game.

Parents, please cheer and support all players during their game.

- 1. Tee Ball is a NON-COMPETITIVE division. There are no umpires, and you don't need to keep a score.
- 2. The games generally last an hour and fifteen mins. With forty-five minutes prep time between the games.
- 3. Managers or coaches may underhand toss after your fourth game. If the player does not hit the ball after three pitches, then the tee must be used.
- 4. One adult must always be in the dugout during the game.
- 5. Helmets must be always worn when batting and base running, no on-deck batters.
- 6. Bat half of your roster per inning. The last batter for the inning hits a homerun/grand slam.
- 7. You can have two base coaches and one coach to help the batter at home plate when your team is on offense. You can have three coaches on the field when your team is on defense.
- 8. Have your whole team play defense. You can place cones on the field if needed, and there is no catcher position.
- 9. Encourage the players to make plays, however, outs do not count. The player stays on the base even if an out was made.
- 10. Before sending your team to the dugout when on defense, wait for the last batter to score at home plate. This prevents players from running into each other.
- 11. The home team sets up the field; Drag the dirt, water the dirt to paint the lines, paint the lines, and install the bases. Have your assistant coaches help you prep the field if needed.
- 12. The visiting team drags the dirt after your game.
- 13. For the last game of the day, the visiting team must lock up the visitors' dugout, porta potty, equipment box, and entry gate.
