THE NEW BATS ARE HERE!!

As highlighted in prior PWLL Quarterly Newsletters, Little League International is changing bat standards for the 2018 season. Effective January 1, 2018, Little League is adopting USA Baseball's new standard for bat performance testing. Bats that were approved for use in the 2017 season *will no longer be acceptable for use in any Little League game or activity* starting on January 1, 2018. Only bats that bear the USA Bat licensing mark (see below) will be permissible for play in little league games and activities after January 1, 2018. For additional information on the new bat standard, visit www.LittleLeague.org. PWLL will pass along any updates on this change as they are released by Little League and USA Baseball.

Along with the other divisions, Tee Ball bats must feature the USA Baseball mark. However, Tee Ball bats that were produced and/or purchased prior to the implementation of the new standard can be "self-certified" using an Approved Tee Ball Sticker via the USA Baseball Tee Ball Sticker Program. This program will allow families to purchase approved stickers marked with the USA Baseball logo and language which reads: ONLY FOR USE WITH APPROVED TEE BALLS. Stickers are available for purchase online via www.USABaseballShop.com.

New USA Baseball approved bats will have one of the following licensing marks:





PWLL TO PURCHASE TEAM BATS

In response to the new bat standards being implemented by Little League International, PWLL will be purchasing team bats for every team in the Major's; AAA; AA; AA; and Coach Pitch divisions. All PWLL players in these divisions will have access to a team bat to use during the season. While players are able to purchase and use their own USA Baseball approved bat during games, there is no need for a PWLL player to feel obligated to do so. We'll have team bats to use!!!

Field Improvements

Because of the generosity of our league sponsors, PWLL has hired Home Field Athletics, Inc. to conduct expert field maintenance over the off-season and have our baseball fields at Lt. Ross Park in great playing condition for Opening Day. The work to be done to the baseball fields includes the following:

- remove all berms from interior and exterior edges of both baseball fields and install new sod.
- align both pitchers mounds, both home plates, and all bases.
- repair pitchers mounds on both baseball fields.
- repair grass area around both pitchers mounds.
- repair AAA field warning track and install stone dust.
- repair areas in front of dugouts

Even with having Home Field Athletics, Inc. coming in to work on the fields and the items completed by the City of Peabody, there's still lots to do during the offseason. Please consider getting involved and help us give our PWLL kids the best little league experience possible. THANK YOU!!!

- PWLL Board Meetings are held monthly all are welcome.




PWLL SUPPORTS THE JIMMY FUND
