COACHES CORNER

This Week's Focus: Preparation & Sportsmanship

TEAM WORK TIP FOR COACHES:

Create moments where players rely on one another. Mix up partners at practice, reinforce communication on every play, and praise unselfish actions just as much as big plays. When kids see teamwork modeled and rewarded, it becomes part of how they play.

FAST TIP: Build teamwork by praising the assist, not just the outcome. Call out good communication, backing up plays, and teammates helping teammates—it teaches players that success is shared.
