Player & Parent Code of Conduct

Players

- Players are expected to attend all games, practices, and other scheduled events on a weekly basis. If a player is going to miss an event, prior notice to the coach is expected.
- Players should be on time and dressed appropriately for all events.
- Players are expected to put their team before themselves.
- Players are expected to show a consistent effort to improve their skills and knowledge of baseball.
- Players should treat other players, coaches, umpires, and all adults with respect.

Parents

- Parents will demand a sports environment for all children that is free from drugs and alcohol, and will refrain from using drugs and alcohol at all Little League events.
- Parents (and their guests) will not engage in any kind of un-sportsman-like conduct with any umpire, coach, player, parent or bystander, including but not limited to: arguing calls; booing; taunting; refusing to shake hands; using profane language; and/or obscene gestures.
- Parents are expected to understand Foothills Little League (FLL) is a not-for-profit volunteer organization. All volunteers must undergo background checks prior to working directly with children. Refunds will only be given in the event a player is injured and unable to play for the remainder of the season, or a player moves out of FLL boundaries.
- Parents are expected to act in a reasonable manner when discussing issues with coaches. Coaches should be available to have a meeting or have a phone conversation to discuss issues concerning players.
- Parents are expected to be supportive of the coaching staff and other players on the team, which includes refraining from "coaching" from the sidelines.
- Parents are expected to make sure that their player makes all scheduled events.
- Parents are expected to make a commitment to the team and the coaching staff.
- Parents are expected to put an emphasis on team and not just their individual player.
- Parents are expected to read and understand these league goals and rules.
