Batting practice may be held in any of the batting cages across the parking lot by the Statesman Baseball Park.

# All games will be played at the Lacey 8-plex. The Lacey 8-plex is located at 2104 Stadium Drive, Oskaloosa, Iowa 52577.

Directions to the Lacey Complex

From the North (New Sharon): From Highway 63 South, turn right (west) at the intersection of Market (Highway 63) and A Ave (Highway 92). Continue heading west until you reach Highway 432 (before Wal Mart). Turn right (north) on Highway 432 and follow Highway 432 until you come to a roundabout. Exit the roundabout at the second exit (Orchard Ave.). Turn left (west) at the first road (250 ft.)

From the South (Eddyville): From Highway 163 use Exit 57. Turn right (east) on Highway 92 and proceed to Highway 432. Turn left (north) on Highway 432 and follow it until you come to a roundabout. Exit the roundabout at the second exit (Orchard Ave.), Turn left (west) at the first road (250 ft.)

From the East (Sigourney): Take Highway 92 West through town. Turn right (north) on Highway 432. Proceed on Highway 432 until you come to a roundabout. Exit the roundabout at the second exit (Orchard Ave.) Turn left (west) at the first road (250 ft.)

**From the West** (Knoxville): From Highway 92, turn north (left) on Highway 432. Proceed until you come to a roundabout. Exit the roundabout at the second exit (Orchard). Turn left (west) at the first road (250 ft.)
