Length of Games:

U-8 4 Quarters @ 9 Minutes. Halftime -5 Minutes, Quarter Breaks- 2 Minutes

U-10 2 Halves @ 20 Minutes. Halftime - 5 Minutes

U-12 2 Halves @ 25 Minutes. Halftime- 5 Minutes

U-14 2 Halves @ 30 Minutes. Halftime-5 Minutes

U8 ONLY, NO OFFSIDE and since we have Goalkeeper for U8 all Fouls inside the Goal box are to be Penalty Kicks.

Type of Awards:

Trophies will be given to 1st & 2nd place teams in all age brackets. Participation Awards will be given to each player with the exception of the 1st & 2nd place teams in all age brackets.

Scoring Systems:

10 Point System Max 1-Point per Goal (Max of 3 points)

6-Points for a win 1-Bonus Point for shutout win

3-Points for a Tie 1-Point deducted per Red Card

1-point deducted for expulsion of a coach, team official, or team affiliated spectator.

Forfeit games will be scored as 2 to 0 (9 points) in favor of them that did not forfeit. In the case a team withdraws at the last minute or does not show, all preliminary games for that team will be scored as a forfeit.

Red carded players and/ or coaches are ineligible for the remainder of the tournament. Golden goal rule will come into play for teams tied in Championship Game only. Preliminary games to decide winner in each

bracket. The highest point gainer in the bracket is the winner. The 2 teams with highest points that are bracket winners go to championship.

Start Times And Forfeits:

Teams must be at the field 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of their game in order to be checked in by the referees or appointed tournament officials. Games will start within 5 minutes of the designated start time. If a team has not taken the field with a minimum of (7) seven players or if neither team takes the field within the 5 minute grace period, no points will be awarded to either team and the game will be declared a double forfeit.

Format:

Three (3) games minimum for each team in tournament (forfeited games will count in game minimum)

Tie Breakers, **NO PROTEST OF GAMES ALLOWED!!**
