## SBSA Adopted MINORS Rules 2019

- 1. Games are 5 innings:
  - a. 5 run limit per inning.
  - b. 5<sup>th</sup> inning, or whichever inning is deemed to be the last, will be unlimited runs.
  - c. 10-run mercy rule in effect after 4 innings.
- 2. Coaches MUST bat their entire roster
- 3. EACH player is required to play 2 innings of defense.
- 4. The coach must remove the pitcher when said pitcher reaches the limit for his/her age:
  - a. Players are eligible to throw 3 innings per game and 6 innings per week. The pitching week begins Monday and runs through Sunday.
  - b. Any pitcher that throws more than two innings in a single day is required to rest two days before their next mound appearance.
  - c. Penalty: Violation of the pitching rule shall result in a forfeit.
  - d. ALL pitch counts will be turned into the CONCESSION stand AFTER EVERY game
- 5. Pitcher re-entry rule will be in effect
  - a. A pitcher may leave the mound for another FIELD position, BUT not be substituted out of the game IF he/she is to RE-ENTER as a pitcher later in the game.
  - b. IF a pitcher hits 2 batters in an inning, he/she will be removed for the remainder of the inning.
    - i. He/she may return to the mound in the next inning BUT
    - ii. If a pitcher hits 3 batters in one game, he/she will be removed from the pitching mound for the duration of the game.
- 6. Time-outs will be allowed during each inning.
  - a. Catchers may call time-out to talk with infield WITHOUT coach present
  - b. Coaches may call 2 time-outs per inning to talk with team/pitcher.
- i. On 2<sup>nd</sup> time-out, coach is REQUIRED to pull the PITCHER from the mound. 7. No intentional walks, four pitches must be thrown.
- 8. Fastball & change-ups only.
  - a. No CURVES or breaking balls allowed, they will be called balls.
- 9. Bats: The bat barrel may not 2 5/8" and must have USA Baseball marking.
- 10. Slash Bunt: A batter is out for illegal action when the player fakes a bunt and then takes a full swing, thus eliminating a player from fake bunting. The batter will be out, the ball is dead and no runners may advance.
- 11. Safety slide is in effect at all bases
  - a. Failure to slide is an OUT
- 12. 46 foot pitching mound, 60 feet bases.
- 13. Stealing is allowed on a PITCHED BALL that crosses home plate.
  - a. NO LEADING OFF Ball must cross home plate before advancing to next base.
    - i. If runner leaves early the team will receive a warning, the next player to violate the rule will be out.
