3) President's Report (Scott):

- a) The Board has two visitors from Nassau join the meeting.
- b) Novus
 - i. The red on the hats will now match Maple Hill red.
 - ii. Novus online ordering will available May 1-May 20,2020. It has been requested that the store be open for 5 months at a time for people to order items.
 - iii. The turn-around time for all merchandise ordered will be 3-3.5 weeks.
- c) All Stars Uniform vote to change official uniform colors from Green/Yellow to Light Blue/Red.
- d) Walsh's stated that they are able to match new colors.
- e) Home Depot will donate the paint for the league dugouts.

- a) Lights all donated through Martin Electric.
