

NABA COVID Policy

November 29, 2021

The following policy outlines North Allegheny Basketball Association's (NABA) 2021-2022 policy concerning COVID-related illnesses and exposures. This policy reflects that of North Allegheny school district, and any changes made to that policy will supersede what is specified below.

- 1) All spectators, coaches, referees, and players on the bench must wear masks. Players and referees on the court do not need to wear masks. NABA will grant medical and religious exemptions to those who have been granted medical and religious exemptions by the North Allegheny school district.

- 2) Guidance after exposure to a positive case of COVID-19
 - a. An unvaccinated or symptomatic vaccinated player or coach who is exposed to a positive case of COVID-19 through close contact, such as living with a COVID-19 positive patient, will be required to stay home for 10 days, or as advised by a licensed medical professional/the Allegheny County Health Department.
 - i. However, if the player or coach tests negative 5-7 days after the exposure, the player or coach may resume participating in games and practices on the 8th day of the quarantine with proof of a negative test.

 - b. A vaccinated asymptomatic player or coach who is exposed to a positive case of COVID-19 through close contact, such as living with a COVID-19 individual patient, may continue attending and participating in NABA games and practices unless they become symptomatic or test positive.

- 3) Guidance after a positive test of COVID-19
 - a. Regardless of vaccination status, players and coaches who test positive can return to NABA games and practices when at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared and 24 hours with no fever without the use of fever-reduction medications and other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving.

- 4) NABA will rely on coaches, parents, spectators and players to adhere to these policies and to self-enforce these policies. The NABA Board will not be responsible for compliance, nor will they expect coaches to enforce these policies.
