WV District 5 Little League Baseball & Softball INTERLEAGUE RULES AND REGULATIONS 2020 Season

- 1. **Medical Releases: MUST** be carried by the Manager or Coach to every game and shall be completed and signed by the umpire or league officer.
- **2. Ejections**: All ejections MUST be reported to the District Administrator within 24 hours
- 3. Home Park: Will supply at least two (2) umpires (one (1) for C-Ball) and baseballs/softballs.
 - **NOTE #1** A Board Member must be present at every game.
 - NOTE #2 Any protest that cannot be solved at the game site, must be called to the District Umpires.
- **4. Cancellations:** Teams **MUST** give opponents a 48-hour notice of cancellation for any reason other than weather conditions.
 - **NOTE #1** Failure to do so will cost the team the cost of umpires for that game.
 - NOTE #2 Games cancelled with a 48-hour notice will be rescheduled one time.
 - **NOTE** #3 Games cancelled with less than a 48-hour notice will be rescheduled one time with the concurrence of both leagues. If both leagues do not agree to reschedule the game, the team canceling will receive a forfeit.
 - **NOTE** #4: All notices of cancellations and reschedules shall go through the leagues' designated person. (Exceptions will be made for last-minute weather cancellations.)
- **5. Rain Outs:** The Home Park Player Agent or designated person will reschedule all rainouts.
- **6. Rain Delays:** A Board Member at the game site will determine when to start the game.
- 7. **Schedules:** Will be set by Manager/Coach for each age group. Each team will have equal games at home and away. A special meeting should be called for Interleague Play and the Presidents or Player Agent for that division and a Manager or Coach of that time must be present to schedule.
- 7. Contact Names: To facilitate contacting teams for rain outs, rescheduling, etc: each league participating in Interleague play will provide the each Manage/Coach and League President with the home phone numbers, cell phone numbers, pager numbers, and email addresses of all managers, coaches, team moms as well as the park phone number at least 2 weeks prior to the first game. Please send District Administrator a complete list.
- **8. Standings:** All Interleague games **will** count in the standings kept by each league.
- **9. Pool Players:** The use of "pool players" in accordance with Regulation V (c) is permissible.
 - NOTE #1: Pool players must play at least 9 consecutive defensive outs and bat once. A Pool Player may not play the following two (2) positions Catcher nor Pitcher.
- 10. Players: All players MUST stay in dugout during the complete game when not in the field or batting.
