Inclement weather: In the case of weather cancellations, the home team's head coach will contact the visiting team's head coach by 3 pm of game day.

Game time: 1 hour, no new innings will start after 55 minutes

Score: Score will be kept.

First Aid Kits: All teams must have one available in the dugout.

Umpire: 1 Umpire will Officiate

Team: All players will play at least one half of the game in the field, with free substitution, and all players will bat in the line-up. To field a team, you must have at least 6 of your own players and may borrow up to 3 from another team. A team may play with 4 outfielders, for a total of 10 players on the field.

Game: A game will be 1 hour with no new innings starting after 55 minutes. 5 run limit per inning. An inning is over when play on the last batter is dead (from an out or run rule) or pitcher has control of the ball in the 16 ft. circle. A game is over after 60 minutes regardless of where they are at in the game. (Games can end in a tie or one team has one more bat than the other).

Pitching/Catching: The pitcher will pitch from 30-35 feet. No wind-up is needed, modified pitching is legal. Coaches must pitch from the rubber at 35 feet. The pitcher must stay in the pitching circle and beside pitching rubber when the coach is pitching. When there is no circle, it is the discretion of the umpire. The circle is 16 feet in diameter around the pitching rubber.

Batting: Each new batter will start with a count of 1 ball and 1 strike. If the count reaches 4 balls, the coach will then pitch assuming the strike count. The coach may throw up to a max of 3 pitches, and the batter must hit or be struck out. There are no walks in this division.

If a team has a U6 player, coaches will pitch 3 pitches. If girls have not hit the ball, a tee will be used and they will get 3 swings to hit the ball. The batter will hit the ball or be struck out, within the 6 pitches. Coach can pitch from the front of the pitcher circle. The pitcher needs to be within the pitcher's circle and beside the pitching rubber. (2020 Amendment)

For example, if the coach comes in to pitch to a batter that already has 2 strikes, the next strike results in an out and the at bat is done. If a batter hits a foul ball on the third strike from a coach or pitcher they will receive another pitch. Batter is out on a dropped third strike ball. NO infield fly rule. If a batter is hit by a pitch whether from a girl/pitcher or coach, they may be awarded 1st base if the umpire feels like an attempt was made to move out of the way. Girls need to be reminded to not throw the bat.

Base Running: NO stealing at any time including home plate. A runner must be hit home to score. If the runner leaves early, the umpire will call time and the runner will return to the base. One base on an overthrow, when the ball leaves the playing field.

Helmets: If helmets come off in the field of play on batter/runner and they do not have a chinstrap on they will be called out.

Game Time: 1 hour 10 minutes, no new innings after 1 hour 5 minutes. **Score:** Mercy rule in effect: 15 runs after 3 innings, 12 after 4, 10 after 5.

Team: Coaches are encouraged to play their players for half of the game (defensively), with free substitution, and all players will bat the line-up. To field a team, you must have at least 6 of your own players and may borrow up to 3 from another team. A team may play with 4 outfielders, for a total of 10 players on the field.

Game: A game will be 1 hour and 10 minutes with no new innings starting after 1 hour and 5 minutes. 5 run limit per inning. An inning is over when play on the last batter is dead or the pitcher has control of the ball in the 16ft. circle. Games can end in a tie.

Pitching/Catching: A pitcher must start with the pivot foot on the rubber and their non-pivot foot in contact with or behind the rubber within 24". The pivot foot must always remain in contact with the pitcher's plate prior to the forward step. A backward step may be taken before, simultaneous with or after the hands are brought together. *(2020 Amendment)* No wind-up is needed, modified pitching is legal. When there is no circle of chalk it is the discretion of the umpire. The circle is 16 feet in diameter around the pitching rubber.

Batting: No pitch count when the batter gets up to bat. **NO** infield fly rule. **NO** Coach Pitch. There will be one (1) warning for a thrown bat and any offense after that the batter will be out. No dropped 3rd strike rule as batter does not advance to 1st on a dropped 3rd strike. They are considered out. Batters can be walked, including walking a runner home.

Base Running: HOME PLATE IS CLOSED UNTIL JUNE 13, 2022.

Runners may steal between 1st and 3rd (1 base/ 1 pitch) anytime in the season. Runner must stay on their base until the ball LEAVES the pitcher's hand, if the runner leaves too soon the runner will be called out.

Rule prior to June 13, 2022: A Runner is never able to steal home plate. A runner can only come home from 1) a hit, 2) a batter is hit by a pitch and forces a runner home, or 3) a batter walks and bases are loaded and the runner is forced home. If a catcher makes a throw down and the ball is missed by the fielder, the runner cannot steal home. (1base/1pitch)

Rule after June 13, 2022: U12 batting and base running rules will apply. Home base is open to steal, but it will still be 1 base / 1 pitch (i.e. they can't steal 3rd base and then on an overthrow to 3rd base then steal home; in order to steal home, they would have to start on 3rd base before the pitch in order to steal home).
