

# TEE BALL RULES

## TEE BALL RULES

Two teams will practice separately but at the same time for 30 minutes, followed by a 30-minute game. Base distance: 40 feet Pitching mound to home plate: 25-30 feet Game time: 30 minutes or 3 innings no new innings will start after 30 minutes. Parents umpire

### Team:

All players will play in the field (utilize extra players in the outfield), with free substitution (rotate kids through all positions), and all players will bat in the line-up each inning regardless of the number of outs. All teams will have a first aid kit in their dugout. There will be one in the shed if needed.

### Game:

A game will be 30 minutes or 3 innings. Each team will bat the entire roster every inning, regardless of the number of outs. No official score will be kept. Base runners are to be called safe or out. The player is to leave the field of play if the result of the play is an out. A game is over after 30 minutes regardless of where they are at in the game.

### Pitching/Catching:

A tee will be used (hence the name tee ball) this will progress the game and get more innings in. The batter will wear a helmet. A catcher is optional. The catcher's equipment is located in the shed at the field if a player wants to play the position of catching. Personal protection is required if a player wants to play the catcher position.

### Batting:

No infield fly rule. Please make sure that all batters do not throw their bats.

### Base Running:

No stealing. One base on an overthrow, that leaves the field of play.
