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ALL IN FC Parent Code of Conduct 2018-2019

We all want to enjoy our kids, watching them grow in a competitive yet positive environment. To do so, we must remind ourselves that our behavior is often mirrored by our own kids. In an effort to create the environment we are looking to create, All IN FC parents are expected to adhere to the following rules:

No Cursing, coaching from the sidelines or criticism of the players or Referees No verbal or physical altercations between parents No other "inappropriate" actions or behavior

A Two-Strike Policy will be adhered to for violations of the parent code of conduct: 1st violation-warning,

2nd violation- suspension (no practices or games) for indeterminate period of time(2 weeks, 2 months, 1 year, etc.)

Physical altercations or threatening behavior is cause for immediate suspension and a review from the AIFC E&G Committee.

If a parent is suspended they have the right to schedule a hearing the AIFC Ethics & Grievance Committee and furthermore with the Ethics & Grievance Committee of GYSA If the parent chooses not to abide by the suspension, the player will not be allowed to play for ALL IN.

Additional Rules:

Parents must wait twenty-four(24) hours after the game to contact a coach with concerns involving that game.

Parents are welcome inside the fence and around the fields during practices but must allow the coaches to coach so the players can concentrate.

Players are expected to arrive at practice on time which means 5-15 minutes before practice begins. If a player has to miss practice, it is **mandatory** to notify the coach via email or phone call before practice begins in regards to their absence.

If a parent has a problem with the behavior of another parent or player, concerns should be brought directly to the coach of the that team. The coach will then handle the problem in consultation with their respective Director of Coaching. Parents are encouraged not to handle problems themselves.



By maintaining a positive outlook and accepting mistakes are a part of the game, we are helping to create the positive atmosphere that our children are asking us for.
